

## WRIGHTSVILLE GREEN SWIMMING POOL RULES

**Please make a note that only two (2) guests per pool pass will be allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

1. Only residents, their guests and absentee homeowners may use the pool. A resident with the exception of live in house guests and members of the immediate family must accompany all guests. The host is responsible for the conduct of his guests. Homeowners who have leased their property will have forfeited the right to have guests except immediate family members. Homeowners will be fined for any resident violation.
2. Pool Hours:                   Between May 1 and October 31  
                                  Adult Swimming:               8 a.m. to 10 a.m.  
                                  Open Use:                       10 a.m. to 10 p.m.
3. Users of the pool must be courteous and alert to any unsafe conditions. Abusive language, boisterous conduct or vandalism will not be tolerated.
4. No littering – put all trash in the provided containers.
5. **No glass containers or breakable objects permitted - cans and plastic or paper glasses/cups are permitted.**
6. No loud playing of radios, cassette players, etc.
7. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied, supervised and protected by a person at least 18 years of age.
8. **Children not yet “toilet trained” must wear approved swim diapers for protection against “accidents.” Should an accident occur, the pool will be closed immediately and chemical will be applied and remain closed for 24 hours and re tested before it can return to sanitary conditions**
9. Small floats only (example-water rings or Styrofoam floats, noodles) are allowed. Storage is not provided in the pool area. Life rings and other safety equipment are for emergency use only.
10. No diving into the pool – no pushing, shoving or running anywhere in the pool area.
11. No pets are permitted in the pool area.
12. All persons are responsible cleaning up all trash they make.
13. Do not remove pool furniture or safety equipment from the pool area.
14. Shower before entering the pool especially if using suntan lotions or oils.
15. All pool parties require prior approval from the Pool Committee and signing of a release for liability purposes. A \$50.00 deposit is required and \$25.00 will be returned after the pool is inspected. Any and all damages are the responsibility of the homeowner. Parties must end by 10 p.m. according to New Hanover County regulations. Residents will be allowed to use the pool during the time of parties. Parking will have to be managed off the Wrightsville Green site. Due to overcrowded and limited parking space and also for safety reasons.
16. All residents must comply with all state, county, city and local rules and/or laws governing pool usage.
17. ...AND MOST IMPORTANT OF ALL, EVERYONE WHO USES THE POOL DOES SO AT THEIR OWN RISK!! The association is not responsible for loss, theft of, or damage to anyone’s personal property.
18. Each resident will be given the code to enter the pool. If the owner gives this number to outside guests, they will be fined \$50.00 and be banned for the remaining season from the pool.

**NOTE: Residents will be fined if the Rules and Regulations are not complied with and will be banned from the pool for the remainder of the season.**

**Remember that the pool is for ONLY homeowners, tenants and guest.**
